#### 1. The Program Coordinator Role

The PC ensured the families signed-in, were served dinner, and received books & door prizes.

#### 2. Book Walk for Preschool Children

During dinner, a facilitator with the night's book is available with blank paper and color utensils to make predictions and wonder about the book.

#### 5. Open-ended Questioning

The Scholar poses questions to participants that do not have right or wrong answers and cannot be answered by yes or no. Storyteller participates in the discussion.

#### 6. Personal Connections Made to Literature

Scholar guides participants to connect prior knowledge to the literature and to share personal experiences to spark deeper discussion around the humanities themes.
